

Lakewood Cabins Pet Policy / Responsibilities / Tips

Your friendly pets are ***always*** welcome at **Lakewood Cabins**. We do not charge for your pets, but we do require a valid credit card number or \$50 cash deposit should there be any damages. You are fully responsible for your pet's behavior while at the cabins. We hope you *and* your pets enjoy themselves with the following helpful tips:

Bring your pets bedding and blankets to protect the furniture – We love pets here at **Lakewood Cabins**, but please remember that the guests after you may not have pets. Therefore, we need to do all we can to keep things fair for everyone! We appreciate your willing compliance.

Bring your pet's food from home – It's not recommended to suddenly switch to a new brand. The altitude (7,000 ft.) may also slightly affect your pet. Remember to bring his/her bowl, leash and favorite toys.

Bring your pet's vaccination record - If you should have an emergency, it will help the local vet and authorities, if necessary.

NEVER leave your pet in the car - Temperatures become unbearable inside your vehicle during the warmer months and often a cracked window is not enough. You wouldn't leave your child in the car with the windows up, would you? Perhaps you could bring a kennel or cage/crate to leave your pet behind for a few hours in the cabin. This way you will be able to enjoy yourself knowing that your pet is safe, and won't wreak havoc in the cabin.

Separation Anxiety – Only you know your pet best. If you think he/she might have anxieties without you in a strange place, do not leave them alone to bark or destroy property (chewing, urinating) unnecessarily.

Pick up after your pets – Please do not let the next guest find your pet's surprises in the cabin common areas or anywhere on the property. Be respectful. Please carry a plastic bag or something to pick it up and dispose of it immediately

Use a leash - Until you know that it's safe for your pet to play off-leash, keep them on a leash. There are numerous hiking trails where you can safely and joyfully take your pets off the leash if you are sure they'll remain close by. While off the leash, do however, be aware of wild animals.
